TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ACCOMMODATIONS: First class hotels based on twin occupancy with bath. Hotel category determined through documentation published by O.H.R.G. Single-room supplement \$80 per night.

MEALS: American Buffet (in Israel the famous Israeli breakfast buffet) and dinner daily throughout the tour. Except that no meals are provided in USA. Extra charge for coffee, tea or other beverage not included in the menu of the day. If a passenger chooses not to have a meal, there will be no refund for unused meals.

TIPS AND TAXES: The tips and taxes are included (and are subject to change.)

SIGHTSEEING: By modern motor coach including services of English speaking guides and entrance fees to places included in the itinerary.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and visa fees, laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters and after-dinner coffee or tea, meals not included in the itinerary, room service, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned. TRAVEL INSURANCE (optional), Maranatha Tours Inc. will automatically bill all passengers for travel insurance unless it is declined at the time of reservation or in writing by the participant.

PASSPORTS, VISAS: A valid US passport is required for US citizens. If you do not have a passport please contact your local passport office. Passports must be valid 6 months after return date. For all other nationalities please consult the country's consulate.

TOUR PRICE: Price is based on international tariffs and rates in effect on Date of proposal and is subject to change without notice should there be a revision in

AIR or LAND rates prior to departure of tour. Price is based on a minimum of passengers using double occupancy. In the event that a minimum of ten (10) passengers does not book the tour within 45 days of departure the agent reserves the right to cancel or re-cost the tour. Late booking or changes may result in an additional fee. Maranatha Tours, Inc. reserves the right to correct invoices, itineraries, and/or brochures without notice.

LAND ONLY: From time to time a tour may be canceled due to not materializing. If you choose to purchase a land only package and arrange your own domestic and international flight independently, Maranatha Tours Inc. will not be responsible for domestic, international flights or transfers of any kind. Maranatha Tours is not responsible for any International flight schedule changes. If domestic tickets are purchased by an individual all penalties and fare differences will be paid by the client.

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION: A deposit of \$300 per person is required to secure reservations, which will be applied to the price of the tour. The balance is to be paid in full no later than 6 weeks prior to departure of the tour. Thereafter, a \$100 late payment fee will be assessed. Reservations made within 30 days of departure are subject to \$75 late reservation charge. All cancellations must be in writing by letter, fax or e-mail to Maranatha Tours and will be in effect on the date of receipt by Maranatha Tours. There is no exception to cancellation fee. Any exceptions must be in writing from Maranatha Tours, Inc. AIR penalties are not part of the percentages below and vary based on the airline policy at the time of airline deposit.

- 91+ Days Prior: No penalty of deposit (Except for \$100.00 per person administration fee plus any airline fees)
- 90-61 Days Prior: (\$300 for international tour, \$500 for international tour and cruise plus any airline fees)
- 60-46 Days Prior: 40% of tour cost
- 45-31 Days Prior: 65% of tour cost
- 30-16 Days Prior: 85% of tour cost
- 15 Days Prior or less: 100% of tour cost

AIR TRANSPORTATION: A round-trip economy class jet; via International air carrier or any other IATA member. Full payment is due 45 days prior to commencement of travel. If the passenger cancels within 35 days of departure or after air tickets are written (whichever comes sooner), then 100% of airfare will be forfeited by passenger. In the event 35 passengers do not book the tour within 90 days of departure, the agent reserves the right to cancel the tour. All airfares are subject to government approval and change without notice. AIR--Because the travel dates are more than 6 months away, the costs and schedules could change. Please Note: A New York overnight may be necessary for any groups traveling from the West Coast, either on the outbound or return. Airline tickets are issued 30 days prior to departure. Seat assignments can be requested but are not guaranteed as tickets are issued in bulk.

ITINERARY CHANGES: If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$90 to \$125 per night per passenger; single rooms- \$130 to \$150 per night. Meals for extra nights are not included.

RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY: Land arrangements including surface transportation: Maranatha Tours, Inc. and the participating Tour Operators operate the land tours offered under this program only as agents of the railroads, car rental contractors, steamship lines, hotels, bus operators, sightseeing contractors and others which provide the actual land arrangements and are not liable for any act, omission, delay, injury, loss or damage or non-performance occurring in connection with these land arrangements. International air carriers and other IATA carriers, steamship lines and other transportation companies whose services are featured in these tours are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board their conveyance. The passage contract in use by these companies when issued shall constitute the sole contract between the companies and the purchaser of these tours and/or passage. The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary, delete or substitute sites when tour operator feels it to be in the best interest of the tour. Maranatha Tours does not provide additional assistance to any passengers that have physical or mobility limitations as tour itineraries require full mobility. Please advise Maranatha Tours if you have any limitations that may impact your tour.

CHANGE FEE: All changes not received in writing by Maranatha Tours at least 45 days prior to departure will incur a \$75 change fee per person for each revision (that is in addition to any other charges per revision once the basic or pre/post tour package has been confirmed).

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary due to emergencies.

DEVIATIONS: Deviations will incur a \$125 fee, plus any other additional costs associated with services included in the basic or pre/post tour. Transfers are included in our group round-trip programs, passengers who deviate or purchase land only packages will be responsible for arriving and leaving independently and must transfer at their own expense.

CREDIT CARDS: All credit card transactions processed by Maranatha Tours directly are subject to a 5% processing fee (excluding the original \$300 deposit).

EXCHANGE RATE FLUCTUATIONS: Foreign currency exchange rates fluctuate daily. For example, in 2010, Euro rates versus the US Dollar fluctuated from a low below 1.10 to over 1.40 (meaning that one Euro cost \$1.10 to \$1.40 US). It is very difficult to set the price of a tour when we cannot predict what exchange rates will do. We price our tours at a set exchange rate and adjust for fluctuations at final billing. If the rate drops below the original rate, we pass the savings on to our passengers. If rates increase, then we must pass those costs on.

**DAY 1 - Thursday, February 23, 2012
NEW YORK / TEL AVIV**

Tour members are welcomed for our departing flight to Tel Aviv via wide-body aircraft arriving the next day. Meals served on board.

**DAY 2 - Friday, February 24, 2012
TEL AVIV**

Upon arrival in Tel Aviv we are met by our guide who will be with us for the time we are in the Holy Land. Board our bus and travel through Tel Aviv, the largest city in Israel. We proceed to Marina Hotel where we will check in for an overnight stay.

**DAY 3 - Saturday, February 25, 2012
TEL AVIV / ASHDOD / ASHKELON / BEERSHEBA / DEAD SEA**

This morning we visit the ancient cities of Ashdod and Ashkelon. Continue to Ashdod, a smaller and newer city and home of the Israeli Navy nautical school. Travel to Ashkelon was an important caravan stop in ancient days; there Delilah snipped Samson's hair. Today it is a popular resort area for modern Israel.

This afternoon we pass through the Region of Adullom, where David took refuge from Saul, and on to the Valley of Elah, the site of David's conquest of the giant Goliath. Walk the battlefield as you remember this great event. Continue on to Beersheba and see the Abraham wells. We will have dinner and an overnight stay at Leonardo Classic Hotel.

**DAY 4 - Sunday, February 26, 2012
DEAD SEA / MASADA / JERICHO / TIBERIAS**

This morning we will have some time for a swim in the Dead Sea or a mud bath that cleanses many skin disorders. We then drive to Masada and ascend by cable car to the magnificent ruins of the fortress where, from 70 to 73 AD, Jewish defenders made their last stand in the Judean revolt against Rome. We see the remains of storehouses, cisterns and a sixth-century Byzantine church. Continuing alongside the Dead Sea, 1300 ft. below sea level -- the lowest spot on earth -- we stop at Ein Gedi. Here we will have time for lunch or to walk to the water falls that David would have used while he was fleeing from Saul.

This afternoon we proceed to Qumran and the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. We travel to Jericho, the world's oldest city. Then we head up to the Jordan River Road to Tiberias. Continue to Ma'agan Kibbutz Hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

**DAY 5 - Monday, February 27, 2012
TIBERIAS / BET SHEAN / SEA OF GALILEE / TIBERIAS**

This morning we follow the Rift Valley running parallel to the Jordan, along the route Jesus most frequently traveled to Jerusalem. We visit Bet Shean at the foot of Mt. Gilboa, where King Saul was slain, see the evidences of Egyptian, Roman and Byzantine occupations, and view the ancient tel, Roman Theater and church mosaics.

In the afternoon we enjoy a relaxing boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, then visit Tabgha and the Mount of Beatitudes. We will walk down to the sea to see where 5,000 people could hear Jesus. We drive back South to Yardenit the Modern Baptismal site located at the exit of the Jordan River from the Sea of Galilee. We will end our day with the renewal of our baptismal vows before we drive to our accommodation at the Ma'agan Kibbutz Hotel in Tiberias for dinner and an overnight stay.

**DAY 6 - Tuesday, February 28, 2012
TIBERIAS / UPPER GALILEE**

This morning we leave Tiberias and head north via Magdala into the valley of Gennesareth to Ginossar to view the New Testament boat found below the sea and to visit the kibbutz. Then on to Chorazin, through the Hula Valley to Hazor, ruins of the powerful Canaanite city destroyed by Joshua and rebuilt by King Jabin and then by Solomon as a chariot city to command upper Galilee. We continue to the northern limits of Jesus' travel as we cross the River Hatzbani to Dan, where we combine a nature walk beside the Upper Jordan with views

of the ancient ruins, topped by the Israelite high place that supported a golden calf (**1 Kings 12**). Then a short drive to Banias (Caesarea Philippi), dedicated to Pan the Greek god of pastures, flocks and shepherds; here Peter made his great profession of faith, recognition of Christ Jesus (**Matthew 16**). Driving along the foot of Mount Hermon, we ascend onto the Golan Plateau for a magnificent view of upper Israel. Return to the Ma'agan Kibbutz Hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

**DAY 7 - Wednesday, February 29, 2012
TIBERIAS / NAZARETH / CAESAREA / JERUSALEM**

We leave Tiberias for Jerusalem; on the way we pass through Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. Continue to Nazareth, boyhood home of Jesus and then proceed across the Plain of Jezreel to Megiddo to visit the excavations of over 20 different civilizations. Visit Muhraka on Mount Carmel where Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal.

In the afternoon we visit Caesarea on the Mediterranean, the Roman aqueduct and port, Crusader's Moat, and the famous Roman Theater. We pass through Tel Aviv on our way to Jaffa (Joppa), the city of Jonah, where Peter had his housetop experience at the home of Simon the Tanner (**Acts 10**). Proceed by way of the Ajalon Valley to Jerusalem. We will have dinner and an overnight stay at Ambassador Hotel.

**DAY 8 - Thursday, March 01, 2012
JERUSALEM / RABBI TUNNEL / TEMPLE INSTITUTE / YAD VASHEM / SHRINE OF THE BOOK**

This morning we will board our bus for our exciting tour to the famous Rabbi Tunnel. Here we will enter by the Western wall plaza and go down to the foundation of the Second Temple. We will see a model that will demonstrate where we are in location to the Temple in the time of Christ. Continue along the tunnel as we proceed to the Gateway of the Priests entry to the Holy of Holies. We will continue to the Temple Institute where we will see the making of the instruments for the new temple. We will see how they are following the Bible for exact instructions. We will see a film explaining where the Rabbi believes the Ark of the Covenant is found.

This afternoon we will head to the Shrine of the book and the model city of Jerusalem at the time of the Second Temple. Return to the Ambassador Hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

**DAY 9 - Friday, March 02, 2012
MT. OF OLIVES / ST. PETER IN GALICANTU / BETHLEHEM**

"If you, even you, had only known on this day what would bring you peace" (Luke 19:42) We start the day with an orientation to Jerusalem from the Mt. of Olives. We then walk the traditional Palm Sunday route to the church known as Dominus Flevit (**"Our Lord weeps"**). After viewing the Golden Gate, we walk downhill to Gethsemane, where we take time to meditate on the Gospel text. Time permitting we will walk through the Kidron Valley, by the tomb of the kings. Here we will get on the road that was left from Jesus' time that takes us to Caiaphas' house. We end seeing the dungeon, whipping post and where the trial took place. Then to the slopes of Mt. Zion there we will visit the Upper Room and King David's Tomb.

This afternoon driving south, we visit Solomon's Pools, Jerusalem's main source of water for almost 2000 years. Passing the monastery of Hortus Conclusus (**"the sealed garden"**) in Artas, we go to Shepherd's Field. We continue our day with a visit in Bethlehem, walking through its alleys and markets to the Church of the Nativity. Return to the Ambassador Hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

**DAY 10 - Saturday, March 03, 2012
OLD CITY / SOUTHERN WALL / VIA DOLOROSA / GARDEN TOMB / USA**

"He has risen!" (Mark 16:6) After breakfast we transfer to the Dung Gate, we walk up to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest site. We ascend to the Dome of the Rock and the Al-Aqsa Mosque, the third holiest site of Islam, located on the traditional site of the ancient Temple Mount. It is believed that here is where the Temple once

stood. Continue to the Southern Wall excavations where we will sit on the Temple steps that Jesus taught from. View a video of Solomon's Temple. Just to the north we find the Pools of Bethesda (**John 5**) and St. Anne's Church, the church is perfectly preserved from the Crusader period -- with remarkable acoustics. We then follow the Way of the Cross (Via Dolorosa) through the bazaars as far as the Holy Sepulcher. From there we walk through the Christian Quarter along the Arab Souks and past the Armenian Quarter.

This afternoon affords the best view of early Jerusalem from the west. **(Here, the Assumptions Fathers suggest, was the house where the High Priest Caiaphas interrogated Jesus.)** From there we board our bus and transfer to the Garden Tomb where we will end our day with a special visit and the possibility of having a private communion on the grounds outside the city walls. Continue to our farewell dinner where we will have our last taste of Israel. Continue on to the airport for our flight back to the U.S.

**DAY 11 - Sunday, March 04, 2012
USA / HOME**

This morning we arrive back in the USA and transfer to our flights home with unforgettable memories to cherish always. Knowing we have walked in the footsteps of Jesus and the early Christians on such a memorable tour will bring new meaning to our Bible reading.
